We need input from seniors and teens! What components do you want this facility to have, so that it meets the needs of your peer groups? What sports or cultural activities would you like to participate in, that the City of Edmonton is not providing adequate opportunities for?

How big can you dream?

- Multiple expandable ice rinks and soccer pitches adaptable to meet international standards with spectators stands
- Performing arts theatre to seat 600 – for public meetings and presentations - for use by the 4 schools planned at the Leger District Park site, meetings, presentations, children's theater, etc
- A beautiful facility that will instill pride and look good in many years to come
- Rooftop café/bistro with view of downtown
- Fitness centre and an indoor 200 m track – maybe in a field house, with a hill component
- Aquatic facility that includes meandering rivers, waterfalls, wave, Olympic, leisure, teach and diving pools with waterslides
- Gymnasia with basketball, volleyball, tennis, racquetball and squash courts and multi-use space for exercise, dance and gymnastics
- Day care facilities with a viewable play area for parents to exercise while knowing their kids are safe
- A community “hub” with areas for spontaneous recreation, for all types of activities and space to offer extension programs from the universities and colleges
- Teen and Senior drop-in space, games rooms and meeting space
- Environmentally Sustainable/Responsible - utilize innovative designs such as geothermal heating, water recycling and reclamation systems
